## 2) Our next food bank collection (Wednesday 28th October, St. Paul's, 2-4 pm)

Our next foodbank collection will be outside St. Paul's from 2-4 pm on Wednesday 28th October (just inside the porch if it is pouring with rain!).

The foodbank currently needs: shaving gel, adult toothbrushes, toothpaste, pump soap, hot chocolate, tinned vegetables, tinned fruit, long life fruit juice, male and female deoderant, spaghetti in sauce, ketchup, custard, long life puddings - especially sponge ones, squash, rice pudding, tinned fish, tinned sweetcorn, tinned meat.

For harvest we took a massive collection of food items and financial gifts from the parish, which was very grateful received. Please let's continue to support this very important cause.
