



## Parish of Nork with Burgh Heath Key Dates - January to April 2023

*Below are some of the key dates for January to April 2023. Thank you very much to all who are involved in contributing to these different events. This is not an exhaustive list, but rather a list of all the dates we have to this point.*

### Worship in our churches

For these four months, we will have a whole parish (joint) service at 10 am at St. Mary's on the first Sunday of every month (please see dates below) and a whole parish (joint) service at 10 am at St. Mary's on the fourth Sunday of every month (please see dates below).

On the other weeks of the month, services will continue at 9 am at St. Paul's and at 11 am at St. Mary's, with the option of Zoom for those who are unable to join us in the buildings.

Community Alive (family services at St. Paul's) will continue to be on the 2nd Sunday of every month at 9 am. Messy Church (family services at St. Mary's) will continue to be on the 3rd Sunday of every month at 11 am. Forest Church (in the St. Paul's Backlands) will resume again in March and more information will follow then.

Our parish 8 am BCP communion service runs at St. Paul's on Tuesday mornings every week.

### Special Services:

On Sunday 22nd January, at 10 am, at our whole parish service at St. Paul's, we will have a **speaker from Open Doors** visiting to share with us about the persecuted church across the world. (This visit will mean that each of our 6 mission partners have now visited us to share with us about the work of these different organisations).

On Sunday 29th January, at 6pm, we will have another **Songs of Praise** service for the whole parish and other guests.

On Wednesday 22nd February, at 7.30 pm there will be an **Ash Wednesday** service at St. Mary's.

On Sunday 5th March, at 10 am, at our whole parish service at St. Mary's, it will be **Ethan Quin's dedication** service.

On Sunday 26th March, at 10 am, at our whole parish service at St. Paul's, it will be our **annual Safeguarding Sunday**

On Saturday 8th April in the evening, **Janet Bennett will be confirmed at Guildford Cathedral**. If you are interested in being confirmed as well, please let me know.
